830 Bellevue

The Grand View Addition to Elgin was created in 1890 and surveyed by W. W. Abell, a locally well-known Elgin architect. The original owner of most of the land that comprised the addition was William Grote, a local realtor, mortgage provider, land speculator and one-time mayor of Elgin.

This home was built by William H. Behrens, an Elgin contractor responsible for three other homes on Bellevue Avenue at 737, 736 and 833. He built several other homes in Elgin in addition to these. He built this home next to his father and mother Ferdinand and Minnie Behrens in 1924. He paid \$425 for the unimproved lot and built this excellent bungalow that same year. The features of this bungalow include the centered dormer on the roof, the earth-tones it has been painted, the tapered or "battered" columns on the porch, the divided light windows and the fireplace in the living room.

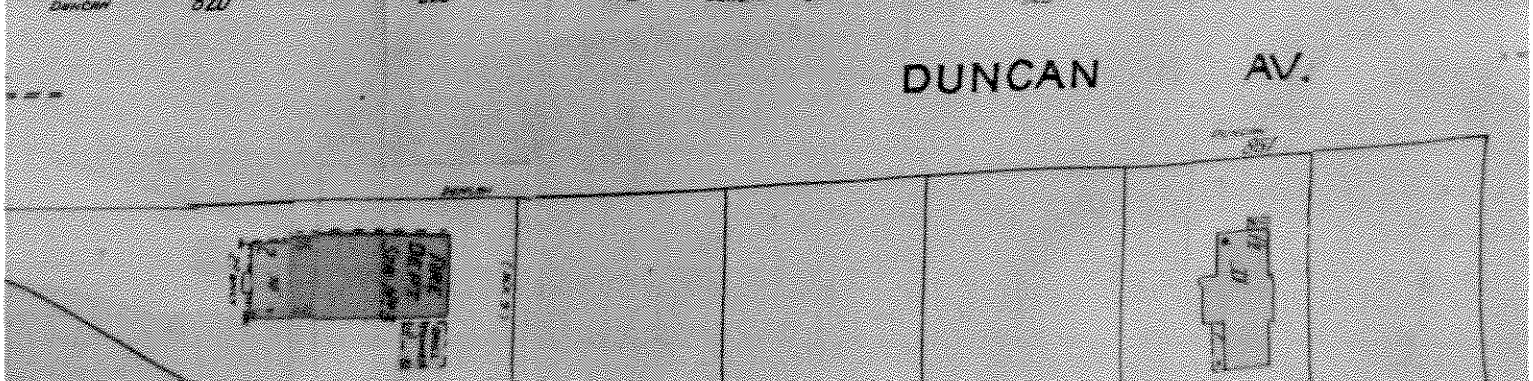
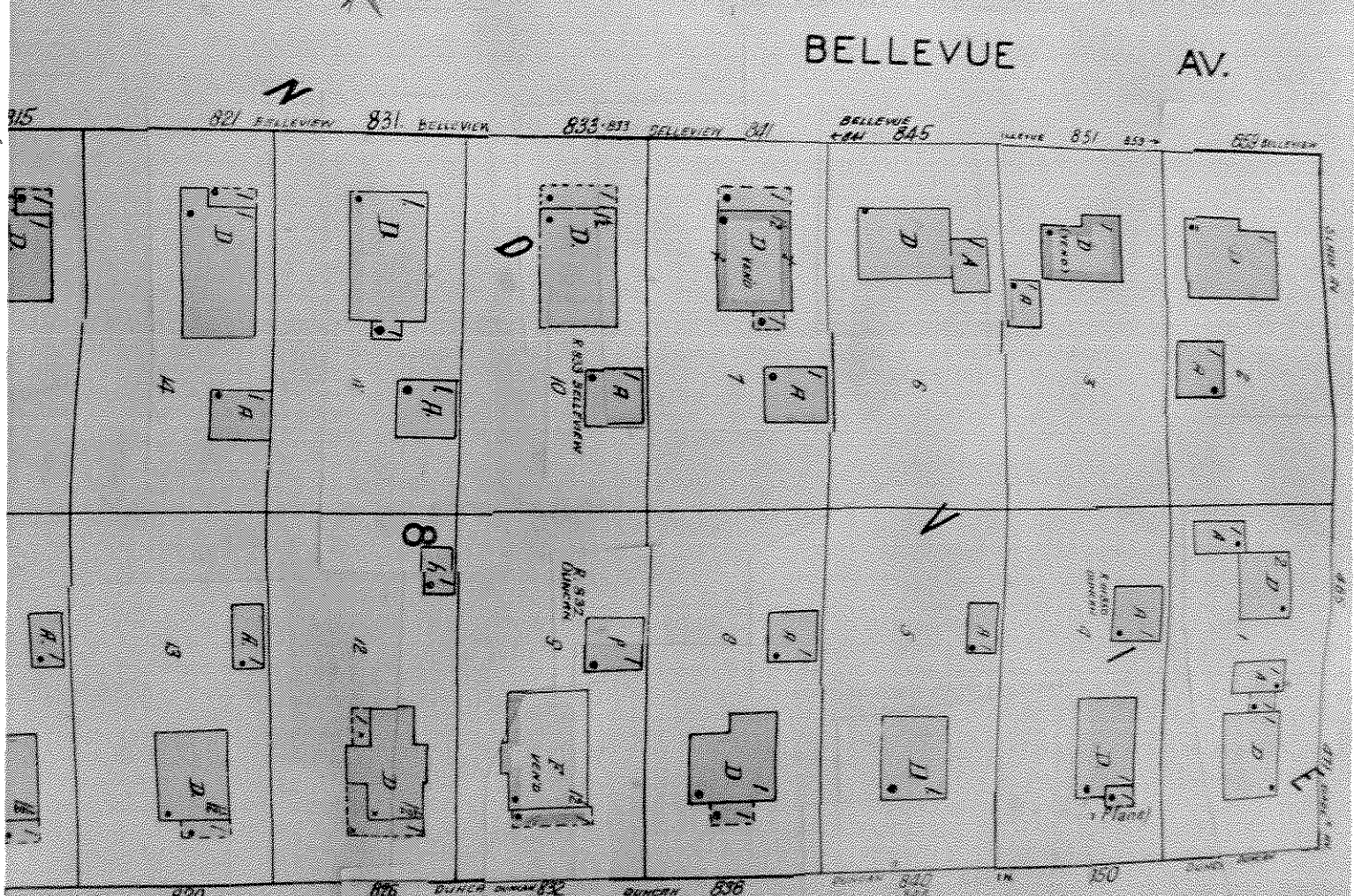
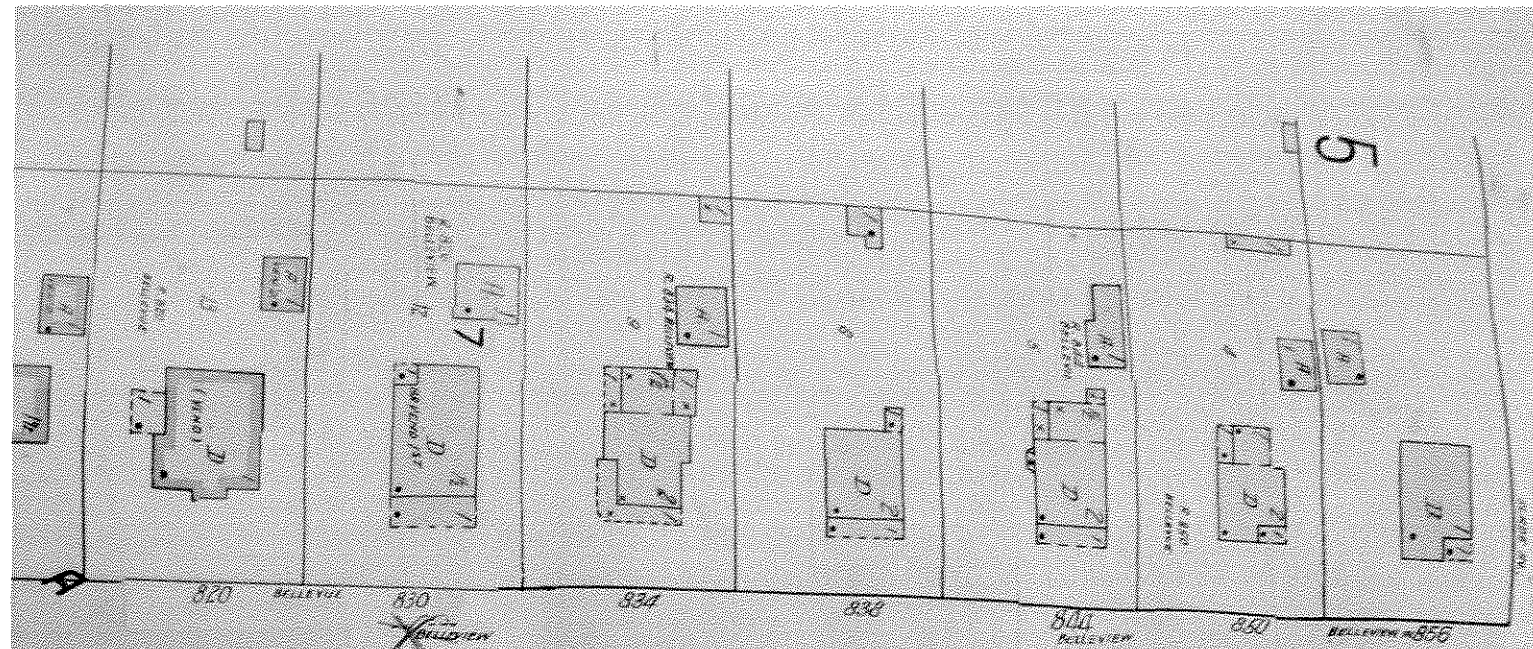

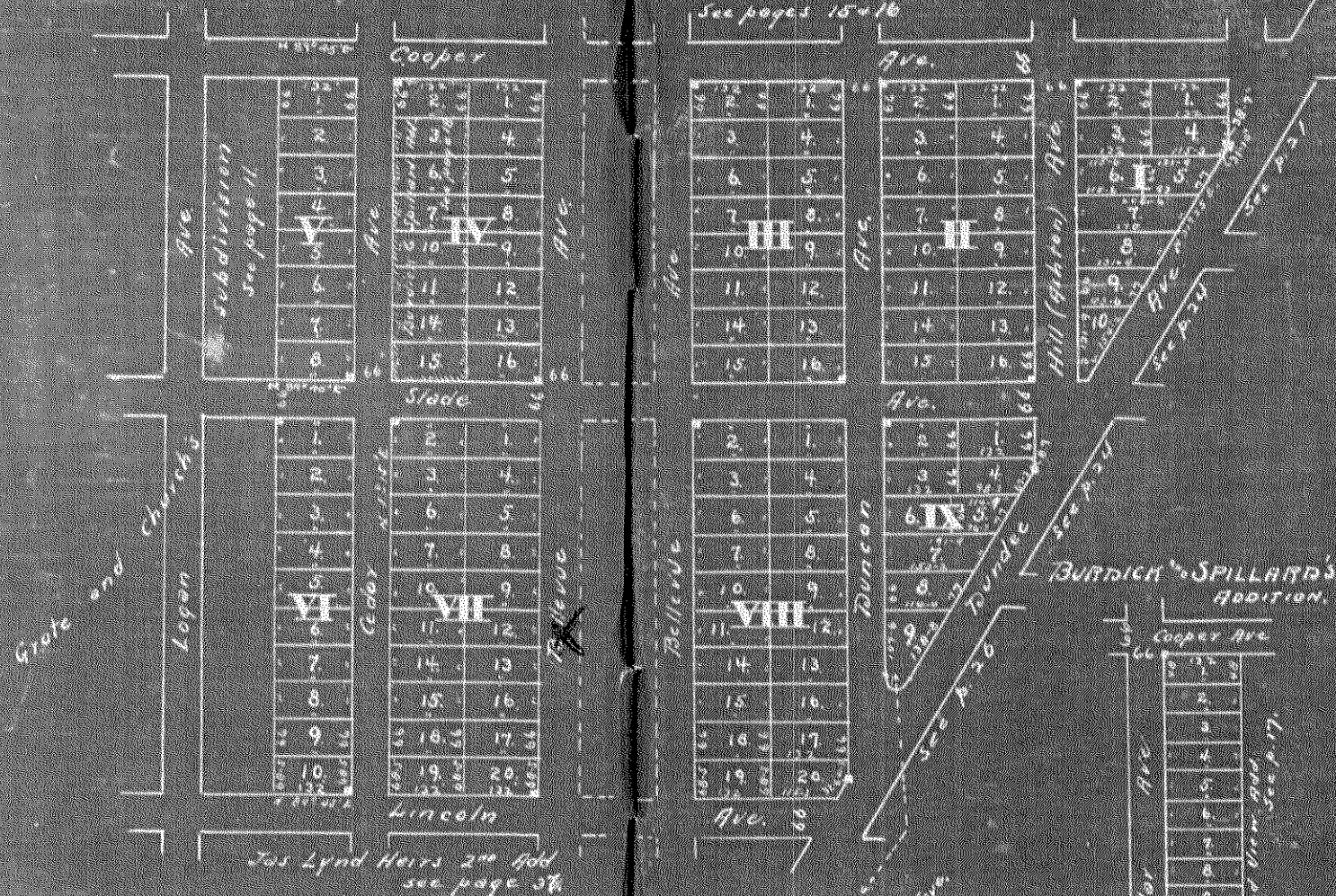
